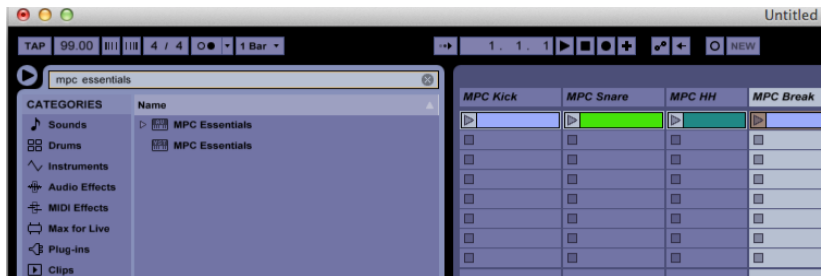




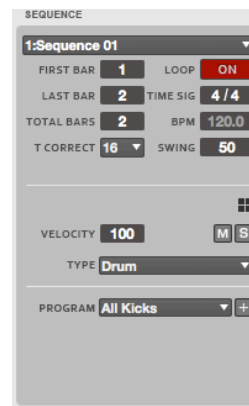
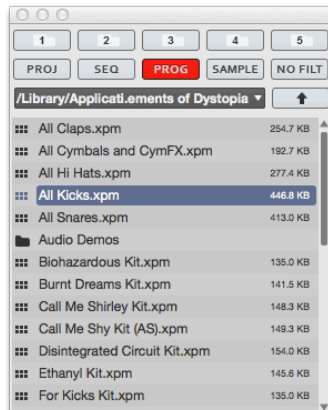
MPC Essentials Software opens up the MPC power-engine to use with your favorite DAW. As stand-alone software, MPC Essentials is made to Sequence Tracks, Edit Programs, and Record, Import & Chop Samples.

Follow this guide to use MPC Essentials as a plug-in within Ableton Live.

1. Locate the “MPC Essentials” VST or AU plug-in



2. Load the MPC Essentials plug-in on four separate tracks
3. Rename these tracks respectively “MPC Kick,” “MPC Snare,” “MPC HH,” “MPC Break”



4. Open the first instance of the MPC Essentials plug-in and load “All Kicks” Program from the factory content folder
5. Do the same for the Snare (All Snares) and Hi Hats (All Hi Hats) instance of the plug-in
6. On track 4, “MPC Break,” load ATL_75_Drumloop_03.wav from the factory content Loop Folder. We’ll use this to showcase the MPC Chop Samples feature.

7. Click the Sample Edit Tab, click CHOP to slice it across the pads, and hit CONVERT to use it as a program.



Chopping loops in MPC Essentials makes it easy to experiment with different rhythmic textures

With MPC Essentials as a plug-in you can supercharge your own samples and loops using the MPC engine for chopping and layering samples. Don't forget you have over 20 filters to use from, including the legendary MPC 3000 filter.
